INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING A POWER OF ATTORNEY ON BOAT TITLE DOCUMENTS

The power of attorney must be exercised by the person or firm named as representative on the form. To properly exercise the power of attorney, write the name of the owner followed by the representative's signature.

Example: John Smith by **Jane Doe** P.O.A.

(John Smith is the owner and Jane Doe is the person named as representative on the power of attorney.)

If the named representative is a company, the representative must sign and countersign.

Example: John Smith by Happy Boating Inc Jane Doe, Title Clerk, P.O.A.

THE POWER OF ATTORNEY <u>MUST</u> BE EXERCISED ON THE TITLE OR DOCUMENT IN ORDER TO BE VALID.
