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OREGON CHIROPRACTIC LICENSE RENEWAL

The Board prefers that all licensees use their original Renewal Notice and Affidavits whenever possible. These blank forms are provided on the chance that your originals have been misplaced.

When completing the forms, PLEASE PRINT. You MUST fill in all the blanks on the forms or indicate N/A, especially:

- (DC) License or (CCA) Certificate Number
- Birth Date (or Month) or July 31 for CCAs
- Licensee Name and mailing address
- The license status for which you are renewing (e.g. Active \$300, Inactive \$175, Limited Active \$225, or Chiropractic Assistant Renewal \$50)
- The payment you are submitting, and
- The number of CE hours due and completed at the time you are signing this Notice/Affidavit (Active 20; Limited Active 6; Inactive 0; or CCAs 6 hours)

You MUST answer the two questions on the chiropractic renewal.

You MUST sign and date the affidavit at the bottom.
