## **Alexander, Vitter Announce Grant Funding for Hessmer**

(Washington D.C.) – U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander and U.S. Sen. David Vitter announced today that the Village of Hessmer in Avoyelles Parish will receive a USDA community facilities grant totaling \$8,575 for rural development.

The funding will be used to purchase a new fully equipped patrol car.

“This grant will enable the force to do its job to its maximum potential, ensuring the safety of the streets and a secure environment for residents and those serving within the police force,” Alexander said.
