In the white papers, LES requests that "the geographic area of assessment for disparate impact purposes.shall be equal to or less than a 4-mile radius from the center of the site" and, if the facility is located within city limits, "the required area of assessment shall be no greater than a radius of 0.6 mile [sic] from the center of the site."
