As the Executive Vice President & General Manager of Leaco, I am writing to express my support for the planned NEF. Leaco is a Rural Telephone Cooperative that provides services throughout Southeastern New Mexico. As one of the many community leaders that has served as a city council person, a board member of the Nor Lea Hospital District, and in such leadership roles, we realize the need, and we welcome and support the efforts of the local communities to diversify our economy. We realize the additional jobs will also increase the tax base providing a better quality of life for all the citizens in the area.

By supporting the construction of this facility, I am, in reality, supporting the creation of 210 permanent jobs at the facility with annual payroll and benefits exceeding thirteen million dollars.
