Driving Directions


1) From North of the Golden Gate Bridge:

-Take the **Last Sausalito exit** off Highway 101, just before the Golden Gate Bridge.

- **Turn right** at the exit stop sign, and follow the road under Highway 101 to a second stop sign.

-Go straight about 500 feet and look immediately for a left turn lane and a sign for "Marin Headlands."

-Go left and wait for the green light before proceeding through the tunnel on Bunker Road.



From South of the Golden Gate Bridge: Just after you cross the Golden

Gate Bridge, -Take the second exit off Highway 101

at Alexander Avenue (after the Vista Point).

-Stay to your right: do not turn left at the exit off-ramp and do not go underneath the freeway.

-**Proceed about 500 feet** until you see a left turn lane and a sign for "Marin Headlands" (do not go down the hill into Sausalito).

-Turn left and wait for the green light before proceeding through the tunnel on Bunker Road.

2) After the tunnel:

-Continue slowly through the housing area (watch for speed bumps).

-Ignore various forks to the left; **always bear to the right** to make sure you stay on Bunker Road. Rodeo Lagoon is your next landmark.

-About halfway alongside the lagoon, the road forks at Old Bunker Road and you will want to **bear left** on Bunker Road towards the beach.

- 3) After the fork:
- -Take your second right

-Turn left at the One Way sign (at the third building on the left).

-The Fire Management Office is on this road, the fourth building on the left. Our building number is **1068.**
