COMPENDIUM AMENDMENT CLOSURE

Golden Gate National Recreation Area Trail Designation - Closed to All Pets

36 CFR Sec. 1.5 (a)(1)

Compendium of designations closures, permit requirements, and other restrictions imposed under discretionary authority by the General Superintendent, Golden Gate National Recreation Area.

In accordance with regulations and the delegated authority provided in Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Parts 1 through 7, authorized by United States Code, Title 16, Section 3, the following regulatory provisions are established for the proper management, protection, government and public use of the Presidio within Golden Gate National Recreation Area, under the jurisdiction of the National Park Service.

• Pets prohibited along the western bluffs of the Presidio, known as "Battery to Bluffs" pedestrian only section of the coastal trail.

The Presidio's western bluffs and dunes support a high number of special status plant and wildlife species, perhaps the highest density of species found within any geographic region of the GGNRA. This closure is necessary to protect those special status plant species located within the trail corridor and the number of special status and locally rare wildlife species. This closure restricting pets amends the 2007 compendium and will be incorporated into the full compendium at the time of the annual review in 2008.
