OSHA REGION VII Electrocutions From Overhead Power Lines

This sheet provides information for employers in the construction industry, on how and where to get information and assistance to comply with current OSHA standards related to electrocutions from overhead power lines.

Responsibilities

As an employer you are responsible under the Occupational Safety and Health Act (the Act) to provide a workplace free from overhead power line hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to your employees.

You must comply with standards, rules and regulations issued by OSHA under the Act. You must be familiar with the standards and make copies available to employees for review upon their request.

Consultation

Employers who want help in recognizing and correcting electrocutions from overhead power line hazards (without citations or penalties) and in improving safety and health programs can get it from a free consultation service largely funded by OSHA and delivered by State governments.
