AUSTIN . . . Texas wheat producers have seeded 5.8 million acres for the 2005 winter wheat crop, down 8 percent from last year, and 12 percent lower than 2003.

"A combination of wet fields, high cattle prices and late cotton harvest discouraged many producers from sowing wheat this year," State Director Robin Roark reported.

Nationally, U.S. seedings of winter wheat for 2005 totaled 41.6 million acres, down 4 percent from 2004.
