AUSTIN . . . According to the Texas Agricultural Statistics Service, the second-quarter wheat stocks for Texas were down 20 percent from last year. Stocks in all positions on December 1 totaled 55.5 million bushels. The on-farm wheat storage, at 3.0 million bushels, was up from the 1.8 million bushels stored on farms a year ago. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 52.5 million bushels, accounted for 95 percent of all wheat stocks.

All sorghum stocks in all positions for Texas totaled 25.9 million cwt on December 1, down 24 percent from the previous year. On-farm stocks totaled 2.6 million cwt was down 6 percent from a year ago. Off-farm sorghum stocks, at 23.2 million cwt, accounted for 90 percent of all sorghum stocks.

U.S. corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 2004, totaled 9.45 billion bushels, up 19 percent from December 1, 2003. All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, totaled 1.43 billion bushels, down 6 percent from a year ago. Grain sorghum in all positions totaled 158 million cwt, up 19 percent from December 1, 2003. Soybeans stored in all positions on December 1, 2004, totaled 2.30 billion bushels, up 36 percent from December 1, 2003. **Oats** in all positions totaled 105 million bushels, down 12 percent from the previous December.
