At the appropriate place, insert the following:

## SEC . REVIEW OF TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ENHANCEMENTS

- (a) REVIEW OF TRANSPORTATION VULNERABILITIES AND FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION SECURITY EFFORTS. The Comptroller General shall conduct a detailed, comprehensive study which shall-
  - (1) review all available intelligence on terrorist threats against aviation, seaport, rail and transit facilities;
  - (2) review all available information on vulnerabilities at aviation, seaport, rail and transit facilities; and
  - (3) review the steps taken by federal agencies since September 11, 2001 to improve aviation, seaport, rail and transit security to determine their effectiveness at protecting passengers and transportation infrastructure from terrorist attack.
- (b) REPORT- Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall prepare and submit to Congress a comprehensive report containing
  - (1) the findings and conclusions from the reviews conducted under subsection (a); and
  - (2) proposed steps to improve any deficiencies found in aviation, seaport, rail and transit security including, to the extent possible, the cost of implementing them.
- (c) REPONSE OF THE SECRETARY. Not later than 90 days after the date on which the report under this section is submitted to the Secretary, the Secretary shall provide to the President and Congress the response of the Department to the recommendations of the report and recommendations of the Department to further protect passengers and transportation infrastructure from terrorist attack.
