On page 116, beginning on line 8, strike all that follows through page 116, line 12 and insert the following:

(2) HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.—

(A) IN GENERAL.— Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Secretary may employ, appoint, discipline, terminate, and fix the compensation, terms, and conditions of Federal employment for such a number of individuals as the Secretary determines to be necessary to carry out the mission of the Department. The Secretary shall establish levels of compensation and other benefits for individuals so employed.

(B) APPLICABLE LAW.— The provisions of title 5, United States Code, shall not apply to the new human resources management system developed and implemented under subparagraph (A), except for—

- (i) section 2302(b), relating to whistleblower protection;
- (ii) sections 3308 through 3320, relating to veterans' preference;
- (iii) section 7116(b)(7), relating to limitations on the right to strike;
- (iv) section 7204, relating to antidiscrimination;
- (v) chapter 73, relating to suitability, security, and conduct;
- (vi) chapter 81, relating to compensation for work injury; and
- (vii) chapters 83, 84, 85, 87, 89, and 90 relating to retirement, unemployment compensation, and insurance coverage.
