COUNT 1

The Grand Jury charges:

That between on or about August 10, 2006, and on or about November 29, 2006, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, defendants, TAMMY K. HOUSTON and TAMMY R. HARRISON, intentionally intercepted, endeavored to intercept, and knowingly aided and abetted the interception and endeavor to intercept, wire and electronic communications, to wit: electronic mail messages (E-Mail) of administrators and employees of the Indian Valley Local School District.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2511(1)(a) and 2.

COUNT 2

The Grand Jury further charges:

That between on or about August 10, 2006, and on or about January 23, 2007, in the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, defendants, TAMMY K. HOUSTON and TAMMY R. HARRISON, knowingly, and with the intent to defraud, possessed, and knowingly aided and abetted the possession of fifteen (15) or more devices, to wit: computer user names and passwords, which were unauthorized access devices.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1029(a)(3) and 2.
