Make sure the way you go to school is safe.

- Look both ways before crossing the street.
- Wait for the school bus only at proper bus stops.
- If your route isn't safe, tell an adult.



Be alert!
Drivers can't always see you.

Play away from the traffic. Go to a playground.



Never walk between cars parked on the street.

Let cars go by before you go after a ball or toy that has rolled into the street.



Be extra alert in bad weather.
It's hard for cars to stop when there is ice and snow.



Wear light colored clothes on rainy or dark days and at night.
