



1 Elm Flats Access



The parking area for this landing is located on a hill above the landing, which requires a walk up from the launching area. This is the beginning of the section of the Pine River that requires a Forest Service water craft permit. Paddling time from here to Dobson Bridge is 2 hours.

4 Peterson Bridge Access



There is short walk from the canoe launch and picnic area to the parking lot. Camping is available in a developed Forest Service campground located on the opposite side of the river. Paddling time from here to Low Bridge is about 2 1/2 to 3 hours.

5 Low Bridge Access



The parking lot for this take out is above the river landing at the top of a hill. Low Bridge is the last access point on the Pine River.

2 Dobson Bridge Access



The parking lot is located at the top of a steep stairway. Paddling time from here to Peterson Bridge is about 2 hours.
