


O'Brien Lake may be hard to find for some, but the journey is worth it. Ask for directions in McKinley, if necessary. O'Brien Lake has cold water trout and the fishing pier is wheelchair accessible. There is a barrier free toilet near the top of the ramp to the pier. The closest camping is at either Alcona Pond campground just west of Glennie or at Mio Pond just north of Mio. Primitive camping can be found at AuSable Loop on the Au Sable River just east of Mio. AuSable Loop is a primitive campground, so bring all the necessities you may need.
