# EMERRGENCY ORDER for OCCUPANCY AND USE NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS

## Park Lake Campground

Pursuant to Title 36 code of Federal Regulations 261.50(a&b), the following restrictions are in effect on the Helena National Forest. These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and become effective when signed and will remain in effect until rescinded.

#### 36 CFR 261.52 - Fire:

### Fire [Title 36, 261.52 (a)]

For the purpose of this order, building, maintaining, attending or using a fire is prohibited yearlong on National Forest lands within a quarter (.25) mile of the high water level of Park Lake located in Section 13, T8N., R5W., depicted in Attachment "A" herby made part of this order.

Exceptions to this order are campfires and charcoal fires that are contained in commercially available product designed for cooking and or warming. Camp stoves or backpacking stoves that are fueled solely by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels are also allowed.

# Fires within rock fire rings are NOT AUTHORIZED.

#### 36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use:

### Camping [Title 36, 261.58 (e)]

For the purpose of this order camping is prohibited yearlong on National Forest lands within a quarter (.25) mile of the high water level of Park Lake.

### **Exceptions:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following are exempt from this order:

- Any person with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- Persons legally occupying a designated campsite within Park Lake Campground.
