





Other areas not included in the mapped drainage areas may, in fact, drain over the landslide hazard areas shown. Where differences occur between what is illustrated on this map and actual site conditions, the actual site conditions shall govern. The offsite analysis, see Core Requirement #2, should assess whether the site drains to the landslide hazard areas shown. Projects outside of the Landslide Hazard Drainage Areas should refer to the Flow Control Applications map for determining the minimum level-of-protection required.
