

The Burden of Seasonal Influenza

- 250,000 to 500,000 deaths globally/yr
- 36,000 deaths and >200,000 hospitalizations/yr in U.S.
- \$37.5 billion in economic costs/yr in U.S. related to influenza and pneumonia
- Ever-present threat of pandemic influenza


Past Antigenic Shifts: Pandemics in the 20th Century
