MOBILE MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO FELON IN POSSESSION OF FIREARM

MOBILE, Ala. - Cleo Jermaine Williams of Mobile, Alabama, named in a One Count Indictment charging him with being a felon in possession of a firearm, has entered a guilty plea, announced United States Attorney for the Southern District of Alabama, Deborah J. Rhodes.

On March 24, 2008, Cleo Jermaine Williams, 25, entered a guilty plea before District Judge Callie S. Granade to the charge of being a felon in possession of a firearm. Williams admitted his guilt to this charge.

Sentencing is set for June 24, 2008 before Chief Judge Callie S. Granade.

This case was investigated by the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives, in close cooperation with the Mobile Police Department. The case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney E. T. Rolison, Jr.
