MOBILE MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO FELON IN POSSESSION OF A FIREARM

MOBILE, Ala. - Steven Mark Yelder of Mobile, Alabama, named in a One Count Indictment charging him with felon in possession of a firearm, has entered a guilty plea, announced United States Attorney for the Southern District of Alabama, Deborah J. Rhodes.

On May 12, 2008, Steven Mark Yelder, 41, entered a guilty plea before Chief District Judge Callie S. Granade to the charge of felon in possession of a firearm. Yelder admitted his guilt to this charge.

Sentencing is set for August 11, 2008 before Chief Judge Callie S. Granade.

This case was investigated by the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives, in close cooperation with the Mobile Police Department. The case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney E. T. Rolison, Jr.
