## **CONECUH MAN CONVICTED ON FIREARM CHARGE**

MOBILE, AL—A Federal Jury in Mobile has convicted a Conecuh County man on a firearms charge, United States Attorney Deborah J. Rhodes of the Southern District of Alabama announced today.

Daniel Stuart Addison, 30, of Castleberry, was arrested by the Conecuh County Sheriff's Office after a search of Addison's residence in December revealed his possession of a Chinese made SKS-type assault rifle. Addison is a convicted felon and under federal law, is prohibited from owning any type of firearm. Addison faces a statutory sentence of up to ten (10) years to serve in prison when he is sentenced on November 21, 2008 before District Judge Kristi Dubose.. Court documents indicate that Addison had been convicted in state court of six felonies prior to his conviction in this case. Under federal sentencing guidelines, because of his criminal history, Addison could face the maximum statutory sentence.

The indictment resulted from a joint investigation conducted by the Conecuh County Sheriff's Office, Evergreen Police Department and ATFE. The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorneys John Cherry and Michele O'Brien.
