MAN CHARGED WITH POSSESSION OF A FIREARM AFTER FELONY CONVICTIONS

PRESS RELEASE

Susan W. Brooks, United States Attorney for the Southern District of Indiana, announced that DARRYL R. FOSTER, 42, Evansville, Indiana, was indicted by a federal grand jury sitting in Indianapolis for possession of a firearm by a felon, following an investigation by the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco Firearms and Explosives.

The indictment alleges that on March 3, 2007, FOSTER possessed a firearm after he had sustained multiple felony convictions in Vanderburgh County, Indiana, courts.

According to Assistant United States Attorney Todd S. Shellenbarger, who is prosecuting the case for the government, FOSTER faces a maximum possible prison sentence of 10 years and a maximum possible fine of \$250,000. An initial hearing will be scheduled for before a U.S. Magistrate Judge in Evansville.

The indictment is an allegation only, and the defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty at trial or by guilty plea.
