VINCENNES MARIJUANA DEALER SENTENCED

PRESS RELEASE

Susan W. Brooks, United States Attorney for the Southern District of Indiana, announced that DAVID WEHRMAN, 25, Evansville and Vincennes, Indiana, was sentenced to 121 months imprisonment today by U.S. District Court Chief Judge Larry J. McKinney following his guilty plea to one count of conspiracy to distribute marijuana. This case was the result of a six-month investigation by the Drug Enforcement Administration, Vincennes Police Department, and Indiana State Police.

WEHRMAN was the source for a marijuana distribution organization that distributed approximately 2,500 pounds of marijuana in the Vincennes area from the summer of 2003 through October 13, 200. WEHRMAN received marijuana from sources in Texas and northern Indiana and supplied a marijuana trafficking cell operating in Vincennes.

According to Assistant United States Attorney Bradley A. Blackington, who prosecuted the case for the government, Chief Judge McKinney also imposed 5 years supervised release following WEHRMAN's release from imprisonment. WEHRMAN will be subjected to random urinalysis and random searches of his person, vehicle, and residence during his term of supervised release.
