VINCENNES MAN SENTENCED TO 15 MONTHS FOR POSSESSION OF STOLEN FIREARMS

PRESS RELEASE

Susan W. Brooks, U. S. Attorney for the Southern District of Indiana, announced that TROY K. STROTHMAN, 19, formerly of Vincennes, Indiana, was sentenced to 15 months imprisonment today by U.S. District Judge Richard L. Young, following his guilty plea to possession of a firearm by a felon and possession of stolen firearms. This case was the result of a investigation by the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco Firearms and Explosives and the Daviess County Sheriff.

Between May 31, 2006, and July 6, 2006, STROTHMAN possessed four firearms in Daviess County, Indiana, after he had been convicted of a felony burglary in Illinois. STROTHMAN also admitted that he knew that the four firearms had been stolen.

According to Assistant U. S. Attorney Todd S. Shellenbarger, who prosecuted the case for the government, Judge Young also imposed 3 years supervised release following STROTHMAN's release from imprisonment. During the period of supervised release, STROTHMAN must participate in a program of drug testing and treatment.
