INDIANAPOLIS MAN TO SERVE 46 MONTHS FOR BEING FELON IN POSSESSION OF FIREARM

PRESS RELEASE

Timothy M. Morrison, Acting United States Attorney for the Southern District of Indiana, announced that ANDRE DAVIS, 30, Indianapolis, was sentenced Thursday to 46 months imprisonment by U.S. District Judge John D. Tinder after his guilty plea to possession of a firearm by a person previously convicted of a felony. This prosecution follows an investigation by the Indiana State Police and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, and is part of the PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS initiative.

_____ On March 5, 2007, law enforcement officers were serving a search warrant on an apartment located on Heritage Court, in Indianapolis. DAVIS was leaving the apartment as police arrived and was found to be carrying a firearm in a holster on his belt. The firearm was a loaded, 9mm, HiPoint, semi-automatic pistol. DAVIS was previously convicted of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon and sentenced to 7 years in prison in 1996 in Dade County, Florida.

Judge Tinder also imposed a period of three years supervised release following DAVIS' completion of his prison term. DAVIS was ordered to undergo drug treatment and to consent to searches while on supervised release.
