TERRE HAUTE INMATE WHO POSSESSED HEROIN SENTENCED TO 30 MONTHS

PRESS RELEASE

Timothy M. Morrison, Acting United States Attorney for the Southern District of Indiana, announced that JOSE SOLEDAD ROBLES-RODRIGUEZ, 25, a Federal Bureau of Prisons inmate, was sentenced today to 30 months imprisonment by U.S. District Chief Judge Larry J. McKinney for possessing heroin, a narcotic drug, at the Terre Haute Penitentiary. The investigation was conducted by the Bureau of Prisons.

On November 10, 2006, after being subjected to a search by correctional officers, ROBLES-RODRIGUEZ had three small bags of heroin concealed in his shoe.

According to Assistant U.S. Attorney James M. Warden, who prosecuted the case for the government, the sentence imposed on ROBLES-RODRIGUEZ will be served consecutively to the sentence he was serving at the time of the offense.
