The Department of Commerce has submitted to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for clearance the following proposal for collection of information under the provisions of the Paperwork Reduction Act (44 U.S.C. Chapter 35).

Agency: National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA).
Title: Highly Migratory Species Tournament Registration and Reporting.
Form Number(s): None.
OMB Approval Number: 0648-0323.
Type of Request: Regular submission.
Burden Hours: 70.
Number of Respondents: 300.
Average Hours Per Response: 2 minutes for a registration form and 20 minutes for a tournament summary report.

Needs and Uses: NOAA would require that operators of fishing tournaments involving Highly Migratory Species (HMS) provide advance identification of the tournament and then, if selected, provide information after the tournament on the HMS that are caught, whether they were kept or

released, the length and weight of the fish, and other information. Completed forms are mailed to NOAA. Most of the data required for post-tournament reporting are already collected in the routine course of tournament operations. The data collected are needed to estimate the total annual catch of these species and to evaluate the impact of tournament fishing in relation to other types of fishing.

Affected Public: Business or other for-profit organizations; not-for-profit institutions.

Frequency: On occasion.

Respondent's Obligation: Mandatory.

Antidumping or Countervailing Duty Order, Finding, or Suspended Investigation; Opportunity to Request Administrative Review

AGENCY: Import Administration, International Trade Administration, Department of Commerce.

ACTION: Notice of opportunity to request administrative review of antidumping or countervailing duty order, finding, or suspended investigation.

Background

Each year during the anniversary month of the publication of an antidumping or countervailing duty order, finding, or suspension of investigation, an interested party, as defined in section 771(9) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (the Act), may request, in accordance with section 351.213 (2002) of the Department of Commerce (the Department) Regulations, that the Department conduct an administrative review of that antidumping or countervailing duty order, finding, or suspended investigation.

Opportunity to Request a Review: Not later than the last day of May 2003, interested parties may request administrative review of the following orders, findings, or suspended investigations, with anniversary dates in May for the following periods:
