Scientific Review Officer

The National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID), the second largest institute of the world renowned National Institutes of Health (NIH), is looking for highly-skilled individuals to serve as Scientific Review Officers (SROs) within the Division of Extramural Activities/Scientific Review Program.

Candidates should have a strong background with basic and/or clinical research in one or more of the following areas: infectious disease; microbiology; cellular/molecular immunology/virology/microbiology of infectious diseases; autoimmunity; transplantation research; parasitology; epidemiology; HIV/AIDS pathogenesis; antimicrobial drug discovery or development; vaccine discovery and development; allergy/asthma research, or significant experience in other biomedical research related to the mission of NIAID, including translational research.

As a Scientific Review Officer you will have two principal roles: to facilitate and manage the scientific peer review of grant, contract and cooperative agreement applications and proposals assigned to the Institute for primary merit review; and to participate in the development and evaluation of new, draft Institute initiatives (RFAs, RFPs, and Program Announcements [PAs]) as well as to assist in the interpretation and implementation of DHHS, NIH, and NIAID policy governing peer review of extramural research programs. SROs will also be expected to manage the peer review of applications and proposals assigned to the Branch and serve as an expert in guiding the activities of Initial Review Groups (IRGs).
