The Erie County Health Department will, within the next few weeks after receiving this completed request, send a Health Inspector to visit your address to perform the following:

- --On-site inspection for rodent activity.
- --Recommendations to reduce rodent activity.
- --Apply rodent bait if necessary once permission has been received from you, the occupant.

It is very important that we all work together to eliminate rats from our area, so we ask that you take the time to do the following:

- --Store garbage in cans with tight-fitting lids at all times.
- --Rid your yard of trash and clean areas behind steps and under wooden decks where rodents may harbor.
- --Cut down high grass and weeds and remove sources of water.
- --Remove bird feeders and stop feeding birds during rodent baiting.
- --Seal any exterior holes in your home's foundation and walls.
