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Dear Colleague:

The National Ambulatory Medical Care Survey (NAMCS) has been collecting data annually since 1989 on office visits to primary care and specialty physicians. The Academy uses these data to estimate the prevalence and type of skin diseases in the United States, to analyze the changes in the practice of dermatology over time, and to project potential manpower needs. This is an important source of data on office-based practice.

I understand that you are being requested to participate in the current survey, and I strongly encourage you to do so. The contribution to be made will come from a small sample of practicing dermatologists, so your participation is critical in providing information on current dermatologic practice.

The Academy has been told that the survey will require no more than 25 minutes per day for a week to complete. Strict confidentiality is assured and only summary data will be published.
