This primitive hunt camp is located in a nicely wooded area along the banks of the Chauga River. The Chauga is one of the popular fishing streams on the district.

During big-game and turkey hunting seasons, the campground is opened for hunters. During the rest of the year, the camp is available for group reservations. Families like to reserve the camp for reunions, cookouts, and camp outs. When the campground is reserved, the general public is excluded from the site.
