Directions: From Westminster, follow Route 76 northwest. Drive approximately 17 miles and turn right onto FS Road 795. Drive .7 mile to the parking area at the end of the road.

Camping: Primitive camping is allowed, but campsites must be greater than 50 feet from streams and trails, and greater than ½ mile from roads.

Difficulty Level: easy

Length: 0.4 miles

Safety: This is an isolated area, so remember to take water, first aid supplies, and insect

repellent.

Season: year-round

Surface type: gravel

Travel Time: 20 minutes (one way)
