I am writing to inform you of my final decision for the Non-native Invasive Plant (NNIP) Control Project Environmental Assessment (EA). On June 1, 2007, I signed the Decision Notice and Finding of No Significant Impact (DN/FONSI) to implement Alternative 2. The DN/FONSI explains my rationale for reaching this final decision.

This DN/FONSI is being sent to those who have requested this document and those that submitted comments during the comment period. Other than a minor citation correction (EA, p. 66), no changes were made to the NNIP Control Project EA or the Biological Evaluation that you received during the 30-day Public Notice and Comment period. Therefore it is not being sent again.

This decision is subject to appeal pursuant to 36 CFR 215. A written notice of appeal must be submitted within 45 calendar days after the Legal Notice is published in The Daily Press, Escanaba, Michigan. The appeal process is outlined on pages 9 and 10 of the DN/FONSI.
