Full payment must be made on the day of the sale. Acceptable forms of payment are Mastercard or VISA credit card, cashier's check, traveler's check, credit union cashier's check issued by a federal or state chartered credit union, postal or commercial money order, and properly endorsed federal, state or local government check. A personal or company check will only be accepted when accompanied by a bank letter guaranteeing payment. This letter must state that the bank will guarantee the check for a specific amount for a period of 30 days after the date of the auction and that it covers the purchase of U.S. Government property only.
