Travel Management Rule Began: 2005 Estimated Completion: 2009

Will establish Travel Suitability AREAS for motorized recreation

Will make ROUTE decisions for over-ground travel on specific roads and trails in "suitable" areas



Will designate areas as "suitable" or "unsuitable" for over-ground motorized travel and over-snow motorized travel . . - ...

Will develop Travel Management Plans for specific Landscape Areas through environmental analyses.



Will establish overall guidance for future Travel Management decisions



Will designate which roads and trails are OPEN to motorized travel. Any road or trail not designated as OPEN will be CLOSED to motorized travel ...

... and enforced under federal law.
