


WEATHER AND CLIMATE INFORMATION

The passing of yesterday's cold front brought some scattered showers, but for now, quiet and dry weather. Varying amounts of rainfall were reported of light, moderate and heavy in locations. Locally, it was the first rain episode since mid-September for Stoneville, which received .41 inches of rainfall, but another Washington County reading was .72 inches per CoCoRaHS. Other Delta observers included Rolling Fork of .30 inches, three reports at Vicksburg of trace rain to .04-.06 inches, and a whopping 4.24 inches at Hernando in the northern Delta.



Temperatures fluctuated prior to the front, often being above normal. The 2008 cumulative total since April is 35.54 inches, above the 30-year normal of 24.69 inches for this time of year.
