How Do These Outlaws 'Ride' Here?

On infested recreational boats and commercial boat haulers from infested waters like Lake Mead, Nevada; Lake Mohave, Nevada; Lake Havasu, California; and other waters along the Colorado River drainage.

How Can We Arrest The Spread?

When leaving the water:

Inspect all exposed surfaces -- Quagga mussels will feel like sandpaper to the touch.

Thoroughly wash the hull of each watercraft once it is out of the water, removing all plants and animal material.

Drain any water through the vessel's hull plug, and ensure the area is dry.

Ensure vessel's lower outboard unit is drained and dry.

Clean and dry any live-well aboard the vessel.

Empty and dry any buckets.

Any vessel traveling from one freshwater water body to another should remain dry and out of water for five days.

Dispose of all bait in the trash.
