Final Department of the Interior Sustainable Buildings Implementation Plan

The Department of the Interior Sustainable Buildings Implementation Plan is completed and signed. There are several milestones that require your special attention and must be completed by the Fourth Quarter of FY 2008, the First Quarter of FY 2009 and the Second Quarter of FY 2009. The remaining milestones will be jointly completed by the members of the Department's Sustainable Buildings Work Group (attached). Your approval and support of your staff to work on these projects is crucial for our collective success on these milestones.

The Department is accountable to the Office of Management and Budget for completion of the Plan milestones (attached). Thus, bureau and office progress on the milestones will be reported via the Department Internal Scorecard process.

The Plan was developed by the Department's Sustainable Buildings Work Group, and signed by Debra Sonderman, Director, Office of Acquisition and Property Management and me. The Implementation Plan provides a roadmap for compliance with the sustainable buildings requirements of EO 13423 - "Strengthening Federal Environmental, Energy, and Transportation *Management.*" The requirements are that:

- 1. New construction and major renovation of agency buildings comply with the Guiding Principles for Federal Leadership in High Performance and Sustainable Buildings set forth in the Federal Leadership in High Performance and Sustainable Buildings Memorandum of Understanding (2006), and
- 2. Fifteen percent of the existing Federal capital asset building inventory of the agency as of the end of FY 2015 incorporates the sustainable practices in the Guiding Principles.

Department of the Interior Sustainable Buildings Implementation Plan MILESTONES

Completed March 2007 – Assistant Secretary - Policy, Management and Budget established a Departmental Sustainable Buildings Implementation Team.

Completed December 2007 – Each Bureau and Office completed the Existing Building Inventory in the Federal Real Property Profile.

Completed April 2008 – Department Sustainable Buildings Implementation Team created a *Guiding Principles Crosswalk to LEED and Green Globes Criteria*.

Completed June 2008 – Department Sustainable Buildings Implementation Team created the Department Sustainable Buildings Implementation Plan.

Completed June 2008 – Department submits the final Department Sustainable Buildings Implementation Plan to the Office of Management and Budget.

* Quarter 4, FY 2008 – Each Bureau and Office will establish a Sustainable Buildings Implementation Team.

Quarter 4, FY 2008 – Department Sustainable Buildings Implementation Team will create a Bureau Plan Template.

Quarter 4, FY 2008 – Department Sustainable Buildings Implementation Team will determine if the Department space management community would like the SBWG to develop a *Green Lease Checklist* similar to or building from the General Services Administration Realty Services Letter on Green Lease Policies and Procedures for Lease Acquisition dated December 27, 2007, the *Department Construction Checklist* or *Department O&M Checklist* as an aid for incorporating the Guiding Principles into new leases.

Quarter 1, FY 2009 – The Department will issue the *Construction Checklist* to the Bureaus.

Quarter 1, FY 2009 – Department Plan updated and submitted to OMB.

- * Quarter 1, FY 2009 Each Bureau and Office will complete the Existing Building Inventory in the Federal Real Property Profile.
- * Quarter 2, FY 2009 Each Bureau and Office will complete their Sustainable Buildings Implementation Plans and submit it to the Office of Environmental Policy and Compliance.

Six Months After the OMB issues High Performance and Sustainable Building Guidance – Department will conduct a gap analysis and start revising policy and guidance, as needed, to incorporate the Guiding Principles into Department's building inventory. The gap analysis will include review of regional factors and opportunities for Department-wide initiatives.

Six Months After the OMB issues the Addendum for Existing Buildings – Department will issue the *O&M Checklist* to the Bureaus.

Three Months After the Department issues the *O&M Checklist* – Department Sustainable Buildings Implementation Team will issue instructions for a sustainability assessment. The Department will issue an official sustainability assessment data call. Or, the Department will comply with an OMB sustainability assessment data call per the FRPP, which ever comes first.

- * Six Months After the Department issues sustainability assessment data call or complies with an OMB FRPP data call, whichever comes first Each Bureau and Office will complete at least 25 percent their survey and computed baseline information on the sustainability of existing buildings including leases. The Department will request, and Bureaus and Offices will provide, an annual report to the Department on the sustainability achievements for that Fiscal Year. The report will include information on new building construction, leases and existing buildings sustainability.
