remittance must be submitted before the quarterly due date to satisfy the sixty (60) day deadline. WARNING: There are no provisions in the Hawaii Employment Security Law and/or Administrative Rules to relax the sixty (60) day filing requirement.

Successor employers failing to file this form with the Division within sixty (60) days after the transfer of the business, may file this form by March 1 of the following year, at which time, if the predecessor employer has filed all reports and paid all contributions due, the experience records of the predecessor and successor employers will be combined to determine the rate for the successor employer for the new calendar year. This form shall be returned unprocessed if submitted on or after December 31 of the calendar year following the calendar year in which the acquisition occurred. Similarly, there are no provisions in the Hawaii Employment Security Law and/or Administrative Rules to relax these filing requirements.

New employing units succeeding two or more predecessor employers simultaneously are treated differently and the Hawaii Employment Security Law should be referred to in these instances.
