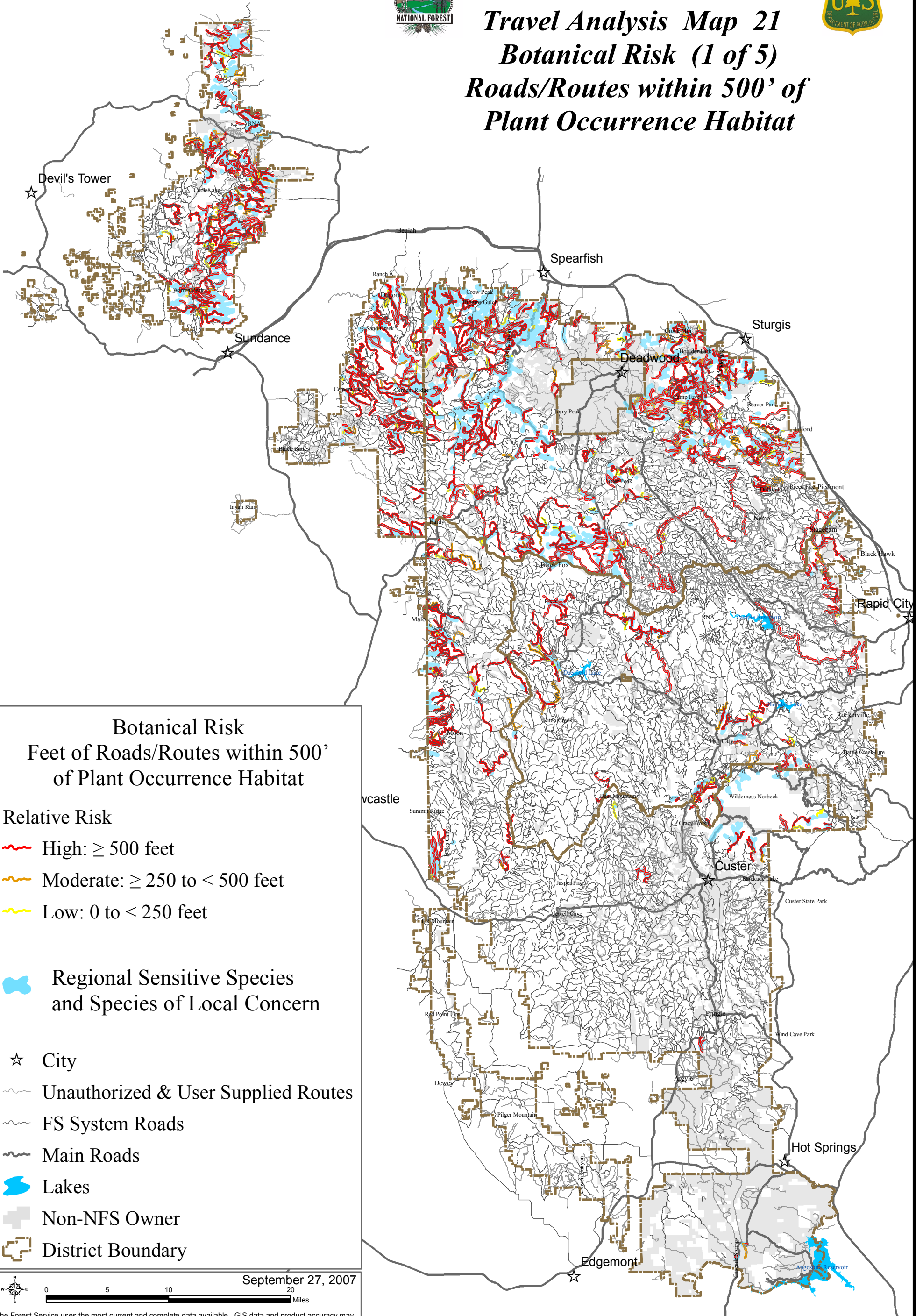







Black Hills National Forest Travel Analysis Map 21 Botanical Risk (1 of 5) Roads/Routes within 500' of Plant Occurrence Habitat
