***Additional Information:** Please read the following information before you complete this form to purchase a Plumas National Forest Personal Use Firewood Permit.

1. The Plumas National Forest Personal Use Firewood Permit is for your own use or the use of your immediate family for domestic purposes. If you are cutting firewood with the primary purpose of selling it to others then you need to apply in-person at the Beckwourth or Mt Hough Ranger District offices listed above and ask to purchase a “commercial firewood permit” (Feather River Ranger District is not available for commercial firewood cutting).

2. The Plumas National Forest Personal Use Firewood Permit is only valid for cutting firewood on lands administered by the Plumas National Forest or the Lassen National Forest. Our firewood permit is not valid on private property or on adjacent national forests. If you are not sure of the location of your planned cutting area(s) please call one of our district offices for assistance. You will need a current Lassen National Forest wood cutting map if you plan on cutting on the Lassen National Forest.

3. A number of terms and conditions will be made a part of the firewood permit. The following are a few of these conditions. For additional requirements call one of the district offices shown above.

- a. This sale is final, not subject to refund and the permit will terminate at the end of the calendar year.
- c. During periods of high fire danger, chainsaw use may be restricted or prohibited. You will be responsible for calling a specified phone number to find out if restrictions are in effect.
- d. Use of tractors, skidders, loaders, or similar heavy equipment is prohibited under this permit.
- e. Your chainsaw is required to have an approved spark arrester and is subject to inspection.
