

Emergency Response Guidelines for Consultation Under the Endangered Species Act

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Endangered Species Act

- The Endangered Species Act of 1973, as amended (16 U.S.C §1531)
 - Provides a means to protect threatened and endangered species and habitats
 - Requires Federal agencies to ensure actions do not jeopardize
- Section 7 Consultation 50 CFR Part 402

No additional requirements for OSC's








- Pre-Spill Planning
 - Informal consultation through the ACP's to develop response strategies
 - Requested in writing by the Area Committee Chair

- Spill Response
 - Emergency consultation
 - Timely recommendations to avoid/minimize impacts to listed species and critical habitat
 - Documentation of incidental take
 - FOSC and Services to both maintain record of communications
 - Action agency's critical mission unchanged – priority is human health and safety






Spill Response Procedures

Post Response

- Adverse effects of the response to species/habitat requires formal consultation
- Written request from FOSC
- Relevant information should be made available for use in the Natural Resource Damage Assessment process
- Impacts of response jointly evaluated by FOSC and the Services
- Biological Opinion issued by involved Service to be used for the benefit of future response actions

Documentation

- Area Committee
 ensures document
 (Biological Opinion)
 becomes part of ACP
 - Appendix to Dispersant or In Situ Burn Plan
 - Reference document
 - Relevant information also included in appropriate sections of ACP



Regional Response Team Involvement

- Workgroup DOI, USCG, FWS, EPA,
 NOAA, NMFS, and States of TX and LA
- Developed guidance (draft) and form for consultation during emergency response for use by OSC's
- Recommendation for area committees to pursue "programmatic" coordination
