VA Puget Sound to announce permanent Northwest Washington CBOC site

MOUNT VERNON, Wash. (June 25, 2008) – VA Puget Sound Health Care System director Stan Johnson, Senator Patty Murray and Representative Rick Larsen are scheduled to hold a 1 p.m. press conference July 2, 2008 at the Mount Vernon Medical Building near Skagit Valley Hospital to formally announce the location of the permanent Northwest Washington VA Puget Sound Community Based Outpatient Clinic.

The new clinic, located near Skagit Valley Hospital at 307 South 13th Street in Mount Vernon, will expand VA Puget Sound's coverage to Skagit, North Snohomish, Whatcom, Island, San Juan and surrounding counties, allowing veterans who live in the region the opportunity to stay close home and not travel to Seattle for routine medical appointments.

In addition to primary care services, the clinic will support mental health, social work, pharmacy, eye, ear, x-ray and dental services. VA Puget Sound hopes the permanent clinic site will eventually serve more than 6,500 veterans.

When the clinic opens in the late spring-early summer of 2009, they will begin seeing currently enrolled veterans. Staff will be on hand to assist all

veterans with enrolling with the VA Healthcare system. Patients who are currently enrolled for care at the interim site in Sedro-Woolley will be notified via mail that their care will be transferred to the Mount Vernon site when it opens in 2009.
