EPA-CDC Symposium on Air Pollution Exposure and Health

- CDC's goal is to develop a tracking system that integrates data about environmental hazards and exposures with data about diseases that are possibly linked to the environment
- Symposium goal is to provide for interdisciplinary dialogue as a means to advance understanding and facilitate applications of exposure research in air pollution health effects analyses.
 - EPA accountability and air pollution health effects research
 - Environmental Public Health Tracking (EPHT)



Symbiosis

- Assumption is that both efforts will need to rely heavily on modeling, thus:
 - Accountability and Tracking efforts will benefit from Air Exposure-Epi modeling experiences, and
 - Modelers efforts will be supplemented by research and data generated by Accountability and Tracking programs
