**The importation of following plants or plant materials is prohibited from the prohibited areas.**

**Additional Requirements (As for the U.S.)**

All consignments of the plants or plant materials described above which are originated from the areas outside of prohibited areas, should be accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate clearly stating the origin as follows;

- when originated from the areas outside of prohibited areas of California, Oregon and New York states: county name shall be stated in the PC
- when originated from the states other than California, Oregon and New York states: state name shall be stated in the PC
