Description of content:</b> AQSIQ proposes to adopt the International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures No.15 "Guidelines for Regulating Wood Packaging Material in International Trade" published by IPPC, and has drafted the measures for the administration of imported wood packaging material. The draft document requests that all wood packaging material entering into the People's Republic of China should be heat treated or fumigated with methyl bromide prior to export and marked with a globally approved mark officially adopted by National Plant Protection Organization of the exporting countries or regions. With regard to coniferous wood packaging material from countries or regions where pine wood nematode occurs, only heat treatment will be approved.
