NOTIFICATION OF EMERGENCY MEASURES

The following communication, received on 7 August 2006, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the Republic of Korea.

Tentative phytosanitary measures to prevent the introduction of Sudden Oak Death Disease

The National Plant Quarantine Service (NPQS), Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry in the Republic of Korea, has modified the "Tentative phytosanitary measures to prevent the introduction of Sudden Oak Death (SOD) Disease", based on the review that 3 new host plants of this disease have been confirmed.

Plants newly added to this measure:

Any propagative materials such as nursery stocks, cuttings and scions, etc. (except seeds and fruits) and woods (including logs) with bark of; Fagus slyvatica L., Kalmia latifolia L. and Salix caprea Floderus.

Enclosure: Import Prohibited plants and areas related to Sudden Oak Death (SOD).

This emergency measure is effective for the consignments shipped on and after 7 August 2006.
