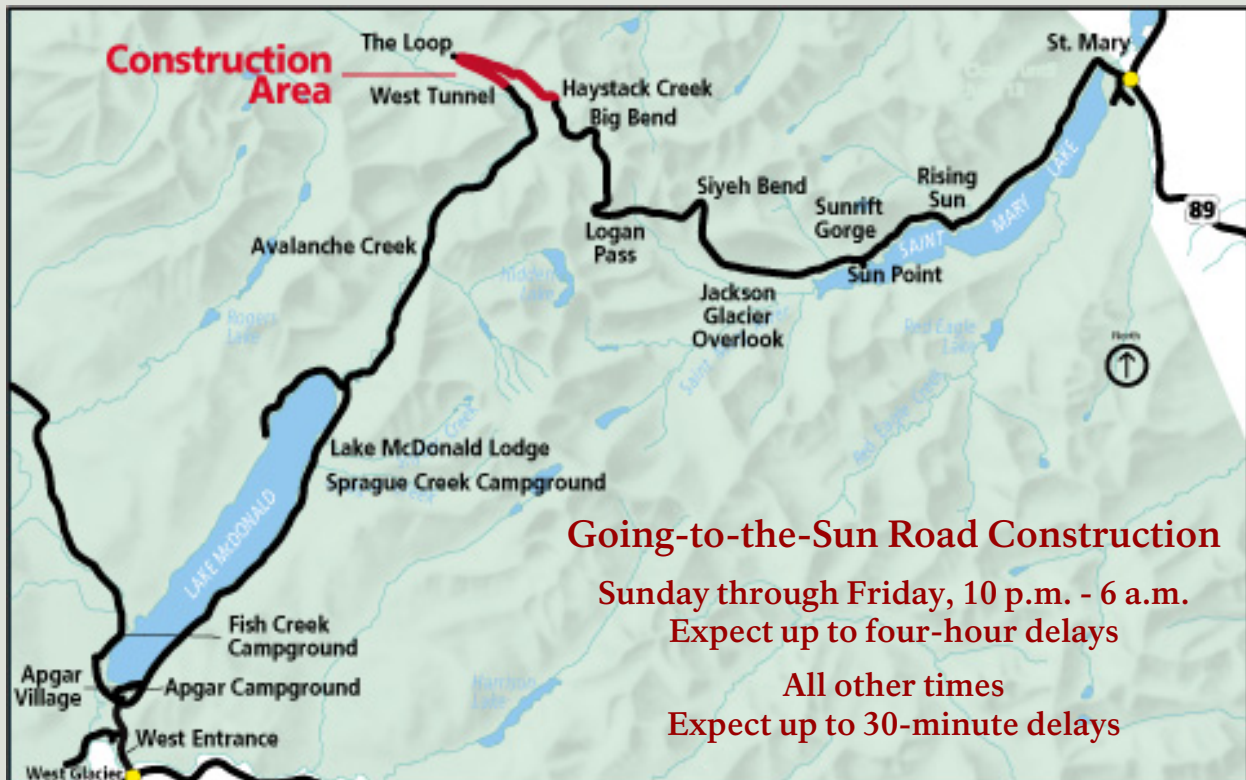
Travel and Construction Update

Expect up to four-hour delays during nighttime construction (Sunday through Friday night, 10 p.m. to 2 a.m. and 2:30 a.m. to 6 a.m.) on the west side of the road between the West Tunnel and Haystack Creek (3.5 miles). All other times expect one-lane directional travel and a narrow corridor with 30-minute delays.

The on-going work at the West Entrance Station will extend the bypass lane for contractors and park staff in order to improve the efficiency of the facility. The visiting public may encounter minor (a few minutes) late-night delays after 9 p.m.

The rehabilitation of the St. Mary Visitor Center parking, walkways, and transit facilities is complete and the center is now fully operational.

All transit operations are in full operation.
