21 22 23	LEVINE	And you know um, they're, they're, they're, they're appointing me, you know. Uh, this,
24	WEINSTEIN	(UI)
25 26 27 28	LEVINE	this way you have a choice. He said you can, you can um, raise a million and a half dollars for the fund raiser in June.
29	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
30 31 32	LEVINE	Or you can work out somethin' with Eddie. Oh and I, and I told Tony that he's supposed to work it out with Eddie.

34 35 36	LEVINE	Tony ga-, gave me such a carte blanche and a met with Steve this morningwe can have uh, uh, you know I, I'm glad

20 21 22	LEVINE	That Asset Manager should also have the ability to do development deals with developers.

25 26 27	LEVINE	I, I, I do, I, I do, well um, there's a guy who works forfirst Lou Williams I think can be involved here.

20	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
21 22 23 24 25	LEVINE	For which teachers you know maybe owns 80 percent of the pro-, of the project and developer 20 percentwe'll be the developer somehow or another and we don't have,
26	WEINSTEIN	(UI).
27	LEVINE	We don't have to come up with money.
28 29	WEINSTEIN	A good, a good place to go will be Kiferbaum.
30	LEVINE	Ki-, Kiferbaum is uh, uh,
31 32 33	WEINSTEIN	He's a builder he doesn't wanna be developer, but he can get a developer front.
34	LEVINE	No, no, that, that, that's true.

1	WEINSTEIN	And, and, and
2	LEVINE	Yeah.
3 4	WEINSTEIN	We can make money on the construction as well.
5 6 7	LEVINE	Right now. Bob, I can with no difficulty get \$500 million dollars put into this uh, asset manager.
8 9	WEINSTEIN	How 'bout just directly into my bank account.
10 11 12	LEVINE	No unfortunately, unfortunate, first of all I have a responsibility to the teachers.
13	WEINSTEIN	I, I, I understand that.
14 15	LEVINE	They can keep 10 percent of their investment.
16 17	WEINSTEIN	Well I, I, I'll be back in a few weeks and do it. But no it, it, it
18 19	LEVINE	And Steve is, Steve is, Steve is right in the middle of this.
20 21 22	WEINSTEIN	No actually Steve, Steve is perfect. Now do you think, you think Tommy will call Eddie?

Maybe, maybe, maybe you wanna find a new, maybe you, you and I will talk and then maybe we'll talk to Kiferbaum, and there may be many, many advantages to, you know to, to, to doing that where um, I, I think
28	LEVINE	Well fine.
29	WEINSTEIN	We're better off that way.
30 31	LEVINE	Fine. The, the, I have not told this to Jacob yet. You know
32	WEINSTEIN	No I mean
33 34 35 36	LEVINE	I thought first I'd check with. You know Ja-, Jacob when I met him uh, uh, this morning went over the, you know the Mercy deal. We went over a variety of

1 2		other things that I'm gonna work on for him. I'm meeting Lee Daniels
3	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
4 5 6 7 8 9	LEVINE	'Cause the College of DuPage has got some stuff. But there are other people that know that the combination of Jacob Kiferbaum, Nick Hurtgen and Bear Stearn's, and Gardner and Carton got Mercy their CON.
10	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
11	LEVINE	That spreads like wildfire.
12	WEINSTEIN	Oh no.
13 14 15 16	LEVINE	There's one goin' up in Lake County I think that we will end up and I said you know now that Mercy was done even though I had to be more up front
17	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
18 19 20	LEVINE	Than I wished to be, um, his credibility is there. You know, nobody has to, uh, you know uh, it's, it's obvious.
21 22 23	WEINSTEIN	No he, he, he is, he is now because of the way in which we dealt with him in the past (UI) is,
24	LEVINE	He, he
25	WEINSTEIN	Is perfect.
26 27 28 29 30 31	LEVINE	Yeah. He, Jacob knows that, and you know what I like about him, he said to me we're going over a few things, he says the bigger the projects the less money you make and the more risk there is.
32	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
33 34	LEVINE	He said um, if I could do projects uh, of, uh you know 5 million or better,

1 2 3		projects of 20, 30, 40, 50 million are, are, are fabulous. 200 million dollar projects
4	WEINSTEIN	You could lose your shirt.
5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	LEVINE	He, yeah, he, he said and, and these are areas where the giants are not competing and they're gonna be doing-if the State gets its education bill passed there's gonna be \$300 million dollars put into new construction of educational facilities. Tony said get ready, he said get us all that you want
13	WEINSTEIN	Stuart. (UI) 10 to 40 million.
14	LEVINE	That's correct.
15	WEINSTEIN	It, it's perfect (UI).
16 17	LEVINE	Absolutely. But that, Jacob, that was Jacob's
18	WEINSTEIN	(UI)
19 20 21 22 23	LEVINE	so he, he, he said to me Stuart, he said there's not a project that I do that I don't make money on and that I don't know where the money comes from. On every

9 10	LEVINE	The, the, yeah the thing that, that with the hotel I think taught him a lesson.
11	WEINSTEIN	Oh no. That, that, that,
12 13 14	LEVINE	And, and, and handling it the way that you handled it showed him, it's like he has a second chance.
15 16	WEINSTEIN	We, we, Stuart you, we have to be honorable.
17	LEVINE	That's right.
18	WEINSTEIN	And predictable.
19	LEVINE	That's correct.
20 21	WEINSTEIN	And, and the predictable is if you screw us we're gonna cut ya. And honorable
22	LEVINE	Yeah.
23	WEINSTEIN	that we only want what's fair.
24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31	LEVINE	Yeah. You know, you know what, you, you were, you were right when you said to me like you know, you said, Tony needs you. He doesn't, it, it's not that he was look but, but I provide-, I, I, when I showed him a list of things that I could of gotten done he never would of known. That was it.
32 33	WEINSTEIN	The, the learning curve to bring someone else in.

14 15 16	WEINSTEIN	He said, he said minimum a hundred a foot. The construction cost would be north of eight million dollars.
17	LEVINE	(UI).
18 19 20 21 22 23 24	WEINSTEIN	Probably would cost us a million to acquire land on southwest 10th Street and then whatever your soft costs are. We turn it profitably. It's the kind, it's the kind of thing 5 years uh, you could probably flip the property for north of 10.
25	LEVINE	Really.
26 27 28	WEINSTEIN	Yeah I mean they, 'cause I, you know I, I was talkin' to people and it's a 1995 building, it's a new building.
29 30 31	LEVINE	Uh, the Northern Trust uh, called up uh, Tothe who's in charge of the Index Fund and uh,
32	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
33 34 35 36	LEVINE	And their, and their trust business uh, uh, uh had a problem uh, with Illinois Teachers put it out to bid, not Teachers, Illinois Employees put it out

1		to bid.
2	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14	LEVINE	So they called up uh, Loren and put 'em into uh, to uh, whatever the fuck his name is the, you know the Blagojevich guy that works for him. And uh, uh, he said you know they're, they, maybe they're gonna raise some money and, and they're gonna pay him a fee. I said fuck that shit. I said what's wrong with you. I said people treated me like shit they haven't given you any legal work they were supposed to. Northern Trust is shit.
15	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23	LEVINE	I said now this is what you do. You have uh, uh, uh, what's his name call back Tothe and say uh, that, that he's asked around and uh, and they got a problem. I said the Illinois Employees is a, looks to direction from Illinois Teachers and you got a problem over at Illinois Teachers.
24	WEINSTEIN	Mmm.
25 26	LEVINE	Which they do. They've been fuckin' some stuff up.
27	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36 37 38 39 40	LEVINE	And they said uh, what you gotta do is uh, you better uh, you know see if you can talk to Levine uh, to straighten this out for you. And, and I said and this time uh, um, uh, they're gonna, they're gonna understand uh, uh, what is uh, um, I said you're gonna get a lot of legal work and I want you to hear this because uh, um, they're gonna come back and I am really gonna let them know uh, uh, what's what and it's not for Teachers. Although they're in trouble with Teachers.

2 3 4 5 6 7	LEVINE	It's for Illinois and I'm gonna tell you got this problem, you got that problem and all this kind of stuff. And uh, and um, uh, uh, they're being sent back to me and being nervous about their business. Uh, is um, uh, somehow
8 9 10	WEINSTEIN	It, it's definitely a benefit but, but in Mel's preliminary conversation with Arbogast they were pretty
11 12	LEVINE	No, no, no I wanna deal with Arbogast on it.
13	WEINSTEIN	Yeah, no
14 15	LEVINE	But I just, I just want you to know this (UI)
16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24	WEINSTEIN	I, I, I agree that they, they, they should be beaten down, you know to, to, to an extent where you know in the future you know life is easy. But um, and, and you know and maybe if we have a, a company their, you know that does you know asset management and development not directly with us, but maybe
25	LEVINE	Yeah that's (UI).
26	WEINSTEIN	A quid pro quo in another world.
27	LEVINE	Right.
28 29	WEINSTEIN	And though, you don't wanna be too direct.
30	LEVINE	No, no that's true. But, but,
31	WEINSTEIN	But
32 33	LEVINE	But I think that I need to be in the center of it.
34	WEINSTEIN	No, oh no it's a good thing. But you

3 4 5 6	LEVINE	Yeah. Al-, also by, by the way I wanna tell you that, that regarding uh, Mel I told uh, Jacob, Blagojevich is gonna, has got a big fund raiser.

15	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
16 17 18	LEVINE	And um, um, uh, I'm gonna get another uh, 50 somehow if I can find another two guys. Maybe you and I will split 25.
19	WEINSTEIN	Okay.
20 21 22 23	LEVINE	Not (UI), but I told uh, uh, Jacob he's to call the guy from Mercy and I want Mercy to hire Topel Forman on the normal accounting stuff.
24	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
25 26 27	LEVINE	I mean 'cause it'll be a good account for Topel and that'll pay back Mel for the,
28	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
29 30	LEVINE	For the 50 that a, that a, that he came up with last time.
31	WEINSTEIN	(UI) can go back for more.
32 33	LEVINE	Right. Well no, but the hospitals are a good place for it.

1	WEINSTEIN	(UI)
2 3	LEVINE	It's good work for them and the, the State work is shit.
4 5 6 7	WEINSTEIN	But the, what do you call it um, the thing down here, uh, if we get the food goin', get these two and then we get a third.
8 9 10 11	LEVINE	It's big. It's incred-, it's incredible. Uh, uh, I'm, I'm lookin' forward to the uh, to the, to the cash flow and uh, and
12 13 14 15	WEINSTEIN	Yeah well I talked, I talked to Mel I'm getting financials for Lake Worth, we, we paid off I guess 100,000 to re-do the roof.
16	LEVINE	Yeah.
17 18 19 20 21	WEINSTEIN	But reimbur-, Mel, we're reimbursing ourselves from stuff that should have been paid by South Florida so I think pretty quickly we'll start getting the first, disbur-, you know disbursement.
22	LEVINE	Yeah.
23 24	WEINSTEIN	Which should be probably, I'm guessin' between 25 to 40,000
25	LEVINE	Yeah.
26	WEINSTEIN	A piece, per quarter.
27 28 29	LEVINE	Yeah. And something else is, this, this, uh, uh, 25,000 a piece per quarter?
30	WEINSTEIN	Per quarter.
31	LEVINE	(UI)
32 33 34	WEINSTEIN	Somewhere each between 25 to 40 a piece per, per quarter from Lake Worth. Soon as, soon as Deerfield is done we're

1 2 3		working on the appraisal right now Deerfield will probably be in the same range also.
4 5	LEVINE	So ultimately that could be 20 grand a month a piece.
6	WEINSTEIN	Oh yeah.
7 8	LEVINE	Yeah. That's great. And you know what else I, I got.
9	WEINSTEIN	And then, and then the food service.
10 11 12 13 14 15 16	LEVINE	Yeah. Let me tell you what, and what else I got. You know there's a commingled fund that is closing in, in, in May that there's a \$750,000 fee that's going to one of Tony's guys and then uh, uh, and then half of it to a contract with you.
17	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
18	LEVINE	But uh, Joe Cari and HealthPoint.
19	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
20 21	LEVINE	I'm getting them another 35 million from uh , (UI).
22 23	WEINSTEIN	Did you have that conversation with Joe Cari?
24	LEVINE	Yes, yes, with help from Illinois State.
25	WEINSTEIN	Mm hm.
26	LEVINE	Uh, and they're gonna pay 2 points.
